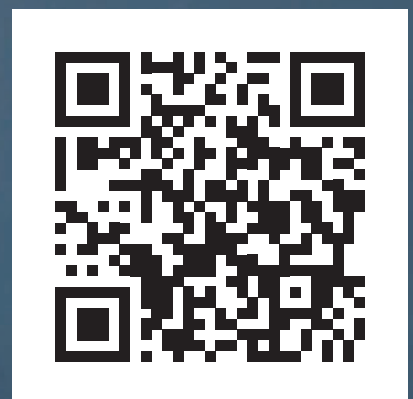

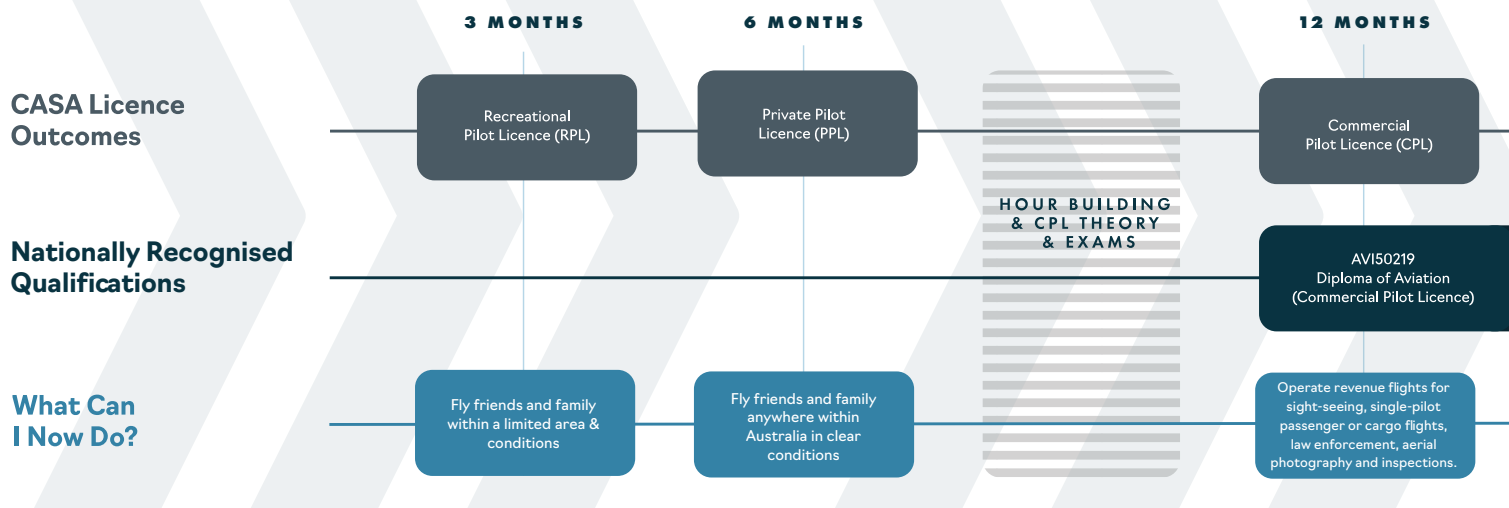

As part of the onboarding process all students undertake an aptitude test to identify each trainee's strengths and weaknesses. We also recommend that if you have never flown, you contact us to book a Trial Instructional Flight (TIF).

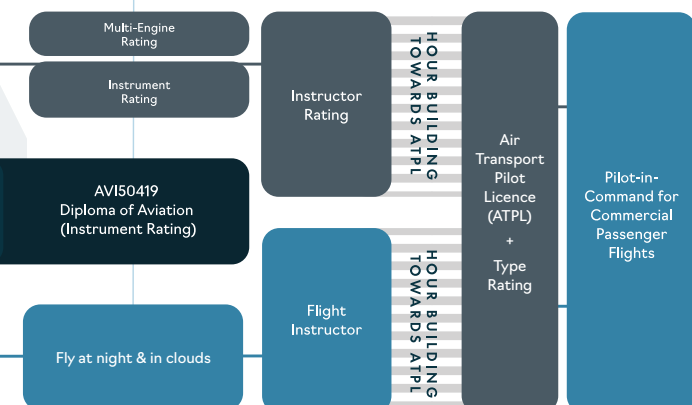

AVIONICS, CERT IV, DIPLOMA - PATHWAY OPTIONS TO SUIT

The pathway to becoming a qualified & fully licenced engineer seems complicated, but it's really quite simple. Choose your specialisation, and pick which course package suits your career plan.

Avionics specialisation involves the repair of electronics - like instruments & circuitry.

Students can select either or both of two streams, avionics (fixing electronic components) or mechanical (fixing mechanised aircraft components) - studying both can give graduates more flexibility within a workshop in terms of how they can be tasked, potentially adding value to their skillset.

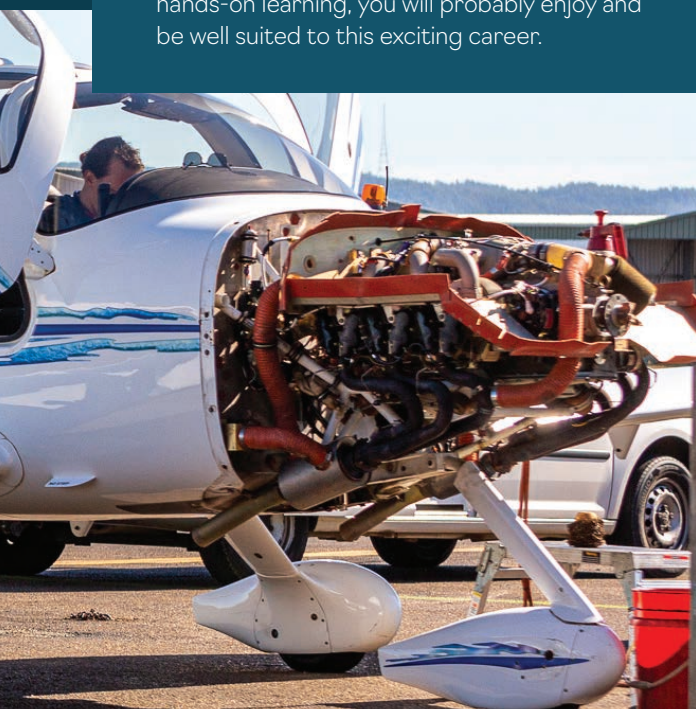
Should I do a degree instead?
